The Power of Noticing Across Language Levels Using DNA-V and The Happy Medium Approach

Join us to explore and use The Noticing Grid from The Happy Medium Approach (HMA) while looking through a DNA-V lens to support learners in the educational setting across languaging levels. Participants will learn about the Acceptance and Commitment Therapy-based DNA-V Model of Psychological Flexibility and The Happy Medium Approach. HMA supports linguistically capable learners move through three stages of intervention: Direct Contingency Management, Setting the Stage for Psychological Flexibility, and Accessing Psychological Flexibility (DNA-V lens). Participants will also learn about using The Noticing Grid to create a clear objective escalation curve for students, creating and organizing reactionary strategies that match the level of escalation, and selecting and organizing new and replacement behavior to support learners in deploying contextually flexible behaviors.
