Adapting Our Practice to New Needs: Trauma in the Educational Setting

Despite the cultural movement to extend the inclusive principles of trauma-informed services to behavior supports and education, many of us lack the training or support to apply this idea. We have not yet acquired meaningful experience teaming with the many essential disciplines that make up a supportive environment after a student has been through trauma. This workshop aims to empower educators and therapists across disciplines to understand some of the links between what students need after trauma, and how we can help. Participants will be equipped with useful tools that may support our students with both significant and minor histories of trauma, and those in between. The workshop will also discuss how trauma relates to others such as peers and other students; and educators and therapists, parents and caregivers, administrators, and funders.
